## A Principle



God's righteousness can **only** come by grace through faith.

***provided*** righteousness vs ***produced*** righteousness

Our righteous "standing" is provided by grace through faith.

Our righteous "walk" is provided by grace through faith.

The Lord has provided for ***both!*** (Our job is to believe Him about it!)
