Resurrection



In what way does our <u>righteous standing</u> before God depend on the resurrection of Christ?

- His resurrection is the proof that His sacrifice for our sins was acceptable to God the Father.

How is the Christian life dependent on the resurrection of Christ?

- Christ *IS* our Chrisitan life! If Christ is not alive, then there is no Christian life.


