#### **A Principle**



# God's righteousness can only come by grace through faith.

*provided* righteousness <u>vs</u> *produced* righteousness

Our <u>righteous "standing"</u> is provided by grace through faith. Our <u>righteous "walk"</u> is provided by grace through faith.

The Lord has provided for *both*! (Our job is to believe Him about it!)

Galatians 3:3 Are you so foolish? Having <u>begun by the Spirit</u>, are you now being <u>perfected by the flesh</u>?
