Now concerning (or about)

spiritual - pneumatikos - meaning those things pertaining to the Spirit, i.e. communicated or imparted by the Holy Spirit - see 1 Cor 2:15, 9:11, 14:1

The word spiritual is used two ways in the New Testament. <u>First</u>, it is used of anything that pertains to the person of the Holy Spirit. <u>Second</u>, it is used to designate the work that He does in the life of the believer.

note "gifts" is in italics – supplied from the context of the Chp 12 passage

1 Cor 12:4 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit.

I do not want you to be unaware.

Lit: I do not want you continue to be unaware

unaware - to be ignorant, not to know

Romans 1:13 I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that often I have planned to come to you (and have been prevented so far) so that I may obtain some fruit among you also, even as among the rest of the Gentiles.

1 Cor 10:1 For I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that our fathers were all under the cloud and all passed through the sea;

² You know that when you were pagans, *you were* led astray to the mute idols, however you were led.

You know that when you were pagans

pagans – an idol, an image to represent a false god

see 1 Cor 6:9-11

you were led astray to the mute idols

led – lit: you were being led – see Rom 8:14 for contrast

mute - lit., "voiceless, or soundless" (aphōnē)

the true God speaks to you through His word!

however you were led

whenever the occasion might arise (Amp)

no one speaking by the Spirit of God says,"Jesus is accursed" by = by means of (under the power and influence of) so what is the ministry of the Holy Spirit?

John 16:14 "He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose it to you.

no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except <u>by</u> the Holy Spirit. by = by means of (same) see 1 John 4:2

Now there are varieties of gifts (present tense – cont. action)

varieties – <u>apportionments or distributions</u> (pass. sense). Here the Apostle does not merely mean the Spirit bestows different gifts, but bestows certain gifts to certain people, not the same to all (1 Cor. 12:7) – <u>only in 1 Cor 12:4-6</u>

gifts – charisma - a gift of grace, a gift involving grace (charis) on the part of God as the donor, is used of His endowments upon believers by the operation of the Holy Spirit in the churches

but the same Spirit

but the [Holy] Spirit remains the same (Amp)

varieties of gifts, but the same <u>Spirit</u>
varieties of ministries, and the same <u>Lord</u>
varieties of effects, but the same <u>God</u>

note the three persons of the Trinity are involved!

ministries - diakonia - service, ministry, is used of apostolic ministry and of the service of believers see Rom 11:13, Eph 4:12, Col 4:17

There are varieties of effects

effects - from *energeia* - (Eng., "energy") - effect, working, energy - in the NT, used only in 1 Cor. 12:6 & 10 of the results of the energy of God in the believer.

there are distinctive varieties of operation [of working to accomplish things] (Amp)

but the same God who works all things in all persons

works - energeō - to work in, to be active, operative and is used of God, the Holy Spirit, the word of God, etc. see Phil 2:13,1 Thess 2:13

but the same God who by His divine energy operates them all in their sphere (Wuest)

⁷ But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

But to each one is given (present - cont. action, pass voice)

is given - dídōmi - to give, bestow upon - spoken of God or of Christ as the author or source of what one has or receives; see John 3:27, John 17:22

But to each one there is constantly being given (Wuest)

the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good

manifestation - a making visible or observable see 2 Cor 4:2

the clearly seen operations of the Spirit (Wuest)

for the common good with a view to the profit (of all) (Wuest)

⁸ For to one is given the <u>word of wisdom</u> through the Spirit, and to another the <u>word of knowledge</u> according to the same Spirit; ⁹ to another <u>faith</u> by the same Spirit, and to another <u>gifts of healing</u> by the one Spirit, ¹⁰ and to another the <u>effecting of miracles</u>, and to another <u>prophecy</u>, and to another the <u>distinguishing of spirits</u>, to another <u>various kinds of tongues</u>, and to another the <u>interpretation of tongues</u>.

Paul mentioned nine ways in which the Spirit manifests Himself through believers. --- Compare this list with other similar ones (cf. vv. 28, 29-30; 7:7; 13:1-3,8; 14:6, 26; Rom. 12:4-8; Eph. 4:11).

Constable

These gifts (1 Cor 12:8-10) ceased with the death of John the last living Apostle – 90 AD (or with tongues in 70 AD) see Eph 2:20, 2 Cor 12:12, Heb 2:1-4,1 Cor 13:8

For to one is given through the intermediate agency of the Spirit a word of wisdom (Wuest)

Applying God's word (i.e. God's wisdom) to specific situations* see 1 John 1:1-3

and to another <u>a word of knowledge</u> according to the same Spirit (Wuest)

Revelation from God about people, circumstances & truth* see Col 2:2-3

Trust God implicitly to perform unusual deeds* see Acts 6:5

works - energeō - to work in, to be active, operative and is used of God, the Holy Spirit, the word of God etc. (same as in verse 6)

distributing - diaireō - to divide into parts, to distribute see Luke 15:12

But all these the one and same Spirit is by divine energy putting into operation, dividing to <u>each one</u> <u>separately</u> even as He desires. (Wuest)
