

# Paul's Authority Established 1:1-2

- a. The Nature of Paul's Office 1a Paul, an apostle
- b. The Origin of Paul's Office 1b-2
  - Defined as not from men
  - <sup>1b</sup> not sent from men nor through the agency of man,
  - Defined as from Jesus Christ and the Father
     1c but through Jesus Christ and God the Father,
     who raised Him from the dead
  - The from and to of the letter
  - <sup>2</sup> and all the brethren who are with me, to the churches of Galatia

# Paul's Greetings Given 1:3

<sup>1:3</sup> Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, - typical see Rom 1:7 etc

### Paul's Doctrine Proclaimed 1:4-5

- the Significance of Christ's Death <sup>1:4a</sup> who gave Himself for our sins
- the Purpose of Christ's Death <sup>1:4b</sup> so that He might rescue us from this present evil age,
- the Plan for Christ's Death 1:4c according to the will of our God and Father,
- for the Glory of God <sup>1:5</sup> to whom be the glory forevermore. Amen.

### Galatians 1:6 - 7 Defection: Its Nature



- <sup>6</sup> I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel;
- <sup>7</sup> which is *really* not another; only there are some who are disturbing you and want to distort the gospel of Christ.

### Galatians 1:6 - 7 Defection: Its Nature



Paul's strong emotions for the Galatian believers is shown by the words he uses: amazed, deserting

Gal 4:19 My children, with whom I am again in labor until Christ is formed in you—

20 but I could wish to be present with you now and to change my tone, for I am perplexed about you.

<sup>6</sup> <u>I am amazed</u> that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel;

l am amazed - thaumazō - to wonder at, marvel lit: to be surprised by the unexpected

present tense continuous action

Luke 2:33 And His father and mother were <u>amazed</u> at the things which were being said about Him.

Luke 8:25 --- They were fearful and <u>amazed</u>, --- that He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey Him?"

John 3:7 Do not be amazed -- that you must be born again

<sup>6</sup> I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him whom called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel;

that you are so quickly deserting

you – Galatians

so - spoken of degree, extent; lit: to such a degree

quickly - tacheōs - quickly, speedily, with haste with a suggestion of rashness

that in such a manner suddenly (Wuest)

1 Tim 5:22 Do not lay hands upon anyone too hastily

- <sup>6</sup> I am amazed that you are so quickly <u>deserting</u> Him where called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel;
  - deserting metatíthēmi to transpose two things, one of which is put in the place of the other.
  - putting something in place of another
     in classical Greek it was used of <u>a turncoat</u> Jude 1:4
     present tense continuous action:
  - lit: in the process of deserting
  - meaning the process was going on but was not yet complete.

This letter is written to halt the desertion. McCalley

<sup>6</sup> I am amazed that you are so quickly <u>deserting Him</u> who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel;

note: the desertion is said to be of Him (Christ)

 when you desert "the truth" you are deserting the source of truth

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

 The source of truth is critical in Paul's gospel. It is the true gospel because the source is from God not men. <sup>6</sup> I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him whom called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel;

### who called you by the grace of Christ

called - kaleō - to call anyone, invite, summon; it is used particularly of the Divine call to partake of the blessings of redemption

**by** - *en* – in or by

the source is Christ, the basis is grace

- every believer is called (one of the many riches of God's grace) – Eph 1:4
- every believer must exercise faith Eph 2:8

6d for a different gospel 7 which is *really* not another which is *really* not another

for - eis - to or into

different – heteros - expresses a qualitative difference and denotes "another of a different sort"

This gospel was not the true gospel!

which\* is not another

another - allos - expresses a numerical difference and denotes "another of the same sort"

This is emphasized by saying it is <u>not</u> of the same sort as the true gospel!

6d for a different gospel 7 which is really not another

### example of heteros and allos

Christ promised to send "another Comforter" (*allos*, "another like Himself," not *heteros*), John 14:16.

Rom. 7:23. After Joseph's death "another king arose," *heteros*, one of quite a different character,

In Paul's day it was Judaizers; today we say legalists

Legalism may be defined: as the mental attitude that man can do something to merit the blessing of God, either in salvation or in sanctification (i.e. our Christian walk)

# This different Gospel – which is no Gospel does the following: part 1



Gal 2:4 --- to bring us into bondage.

Gal 2:16 --- no flesh will be justified by the works of the Law

Gal 2:21a nullify the grace of God – "if righteousness comes through the Law"

Gal 2:21b then Christ died needlessly - "if righteousness comes through the Law"

# This different Gospel – which is no Gospel does the following: part 2



Gal 3:10a For as many as are of the works of the Law are under a curse;

Gal 5:1 --- subject again to a yoke of slavery.

Gal 5:4a You have been severed from Christ, you who are seeking to be justified by law;

Gal 5:4b you have fallen from grace.

### The True Gospel According to Paul



Gospel - euangelizō - to bring or announce glad tidings

Paul uses it in two ways:\*

Narrow sense (plan of salvation focus)

1 Cor 15:3 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that <u>Christ died</u> for our sins according to the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> and that <u>He was buried</u>, and that <u>He was raised</u> on the third day according to the Scriptures, <sup>5</sup> and that He <u>appeared</u> to Cephas, then to the twelve.

- and that not of yourselves,

- <sup>9</sup> not as a result of works,
- so that no one may boast.
