
Gal 4:1-7 Position/Condition





The Principle of Position

Principle.

A comprehensive and fundamental law, doctrine, or assumption. The laws or facts of nature underlying the working of an artificial device.

Position.

To lay down, put or place. The act of placing or arranging. The point or area occupied by a physical object.

Source. A point of origin or procurement:

beginning. One that originates. The point of origin.
