Col. 2:11: **IN HIM you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands**, by the putting off of the body of the sins of the flesh

to circumcise = peritemnō

- In spiritual circumcision IN CHRIST
- the whole corrupt, carnal nature is put away like a garment which is taken off and laid aside."
- Body of the Flesh/SinNature is not eradicated
- Its power is broken, and it has no more power over the believer than he allows it to have.
- The physical body was once dominated by the evil nature is put away
- Now in Christ: your physical body is now dominated by the divine nature/ New Man in Christ.



Verb: **ek**duomai = putting off Note: **ek** = (out of) one's clothes



Col. 2:11: IN HIM you were also circumcised with THE circumcision made without hands, by (means of) the putting off of the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ,

Compare ekduomai = *putting off* one's clothes in Colossians 2:11



to: en-dü'-ō in Colossians 3:10:

(covered in upcoming weeks)

"(since you have laid aside the old self)...
and have <u>put on</u> the new self who is being renewed to a true knowledge according to the image of the One who created him—"

endyō = sink into (clothing), put on, clothe one's self

Endyō: put on one's clothes



How did we receive the spiritual circumcision / the circumcision of Christ?

- By MEANS of: Baptism
- Verse 12: "co-buried with Him in THE BAPTISM, in which you were also co-raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead"
- Same exact principle as Romans 6
- In greek: "buried" and "raised" have the modifier that renders them both: "Together WITH"
- Now: What is Spiritual Baptism/ the baptism of Christ?



Βάπτισμα = baptisma

How did we receive the spiritual circumcision / the circumcision of Christ?

- Verse 11-12 is rendered: "in Whom you are circumcised by the by means of being co-buried with Him in THE baptism, in which you were also raised with Him through faith" (summarized)







The Working of God in the Identification with Christ in THE baptism

Vs. 12: ... "co-buried with Him in the baptism, in which you were also co-raised with Him through faith **in the working of God**, who raised Him from the dead,"

- Working = ἐνέργεια = energeia
- Energeia = is only used in N.T. as only a supernatural working Energeia = also, an OPERATION of God

Summing up Col. 2:11-12, I.

- Gnostic proponents were coming into Colossae mixing Eastern mysticism & theosophy with Mosaic requirements such as circumcision
- This is similar to Acts 15: "Certain men came down from Judea teaching, "unless ye be circumcized according to Moses...."
- Or: Gal. 2:3: Paul brought Titus to demonstrate the fact that being physically circumcised was not in accordance with grace; (covered in the 10 a.m. service recently)
- Gal. 3:3 "Are you made perfect (complete) by the flesh? (this same question could be posed to these Colossians)

Summing up Col. 2:11-12, II.

- Paul does not make an argument against their claims, but presents instead <u>Christ</u> in His fullness, and the fact that the Colossians were "in Him", completely full with His fullness, (they are Complete in Him)
- Why do you want to become circumcised when you ALREADY HAVE BEEN circumcised with the spiritual circumcision of Christ?
- By means of spiritual baptism, explaining to them that they have been permanently immersed and placed forever in Christ: His death, His burial & His raising again
- Their sin nature has been dealt with: condemned, and separated from them
- Skipping to Col. 3:11: "There is neither circumcised nor uncircumcised: BUT CHRIST is all in all

Who shall deliver me from this body of death? [Rom. 7:25]
