



# The Essential Character of God's Riches of Divine Grace

- 1. They are <u>not</u> experienced
- 2. They are <u>not</u> progressive
- 3. They are in no way related to human merit
- 4. They are eternal in their character
- 5. They are known only through the Word of God
- 6. They are not produced by man but by God alone

# 1. They are <u>not</u> experienced

- They are facts of the newly created life out of which experiences may grow
- For example, justification is never experienced; yet it is a new eternal fact of divine life and relationship to God
- Rom 5:1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- Another example see 2 Cor. 5:21

# 2. They are not progressive

- They do not grow, or develop, from a small beginning
- They are as perfect and complete the instant they are possessed as they ever will be in the ages to come

A son does not grow into fuller sonship example: see Gal. 3:26, 1 Cor. 4:17

 An old man is no more the son of his earthly father at the day of his death than he was at the day of his birth

# 3. They are not related to human merit

- It was while we were yet sinners that Christ died for the ungodly - see Rom 5:8
- These riches of grace are built solely on the merits of Christ
- The believer is made to stand on the unchanging Person of the Son of God – see Rom 14:4
- The Christian is accepted (now and forever) in the beloved - see Rom 15:7

### 4. They are eternal in their character

- The imparted life of God is as eternal in its character as Christ himself.
- Hence the Word of His Grace says: "I give unto them eternal life and they shall never perish." (John 10:28)
- The realization of such a relationship to God may vary in the daily walk of the believer
- The facts of the new life are never subject to change in time or eternity example John 6:40

# 5. They are known only through of the Word of God

- They defy human imagination, and since they cannot be experienced, their reality can be entered into only by believing the Word of God
- These eternal riches of grace are for everyone who believes
- Example see 1 Thess. 2:13

# 6. They are not produced by man but by God alone

- An unbeliever can take no step (other than faith in what God has done for him) in the direction of his own salvation
- The riches of God's grace are His work alone
- Only God can translate an unbeliever out of the power of darkness into the kingdom of His beloved Son
- Only God can make him a citizen of heaven
- God alone is able to provide salvation to all those who put their trust in Him
