- <sup>33</sup> (As in all the churches of the saints)<sup>34</sup> The women are to keep silent in the churches; for they are not permitted to speak, but are to subject themselves, just as the Law also says.
  - Sometimes we think that we can improve upon what God has commanded, but we may be sure of this: that His ways are always best.
  - The true test of love for Christ is conformity to His Word.
  - He knows best what each one of us should do in order to glorify Him.
- <sup>35</sup> If they desire to learn anything, let them ask their own husbands at home; for it is improper for a woman to speak in church.
  - Rather than calling out a question in the middle of some male or female prophet's message, a woman was to wait and ask her husband about it at home after the service.
  - Presumably, unmarried women would ask their fathers or some other man in the church after the service.
- <sup>36</sup> Was it from you that the word of God first went forth? Or has it come to you only?
  - They did not set the standard for how the church meetings should proceed.
  - The Corinthian church was not the mother church.
  - The Corinthian readers should submit to the apostle's direction.
- <sup>37</sup> If anyone thinks he is a prophet or spiritual, let him recognize that the things which I write to you are the Lord's commandment.
  - Submission to apostolic authority was the test, not speaking in tongues.
  - Submissiveness to the apostles and their teaching was an expression of submission to the Lord Himself (cf. 7:10, 25). It still is.
- <sup>38</sup> But if anyone does not recognize this, he is not recognized.
  - The Corinthians should not recognize anyone who refused to acknowledge the apostle's authority.
  - Failure to recognize the Lord as the source of Paul's teaching would lead to that person's failure to be acknowledged with approval) by the Lord
- <sup>39</sup> Therefore, my brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak in tongues.
  - Prophecy is the priority. Tongues are to be regulated, but not forbidden.
- <sup>40</sup> But all things must be done properly and in an orderly manner.
  - Christians should do everything in a decent and orderly manner, everything should be edifying (v. 26), and a spirit of peace should prevail (v. 33).
