1:12 -14 Christ's life is out from God's grace and not human wisdom

1:15 -17 Paul explains his plans and asks questions of the Corinthians

1:18 -20 Christ's faithfulness is never yes and no but yes in Him

V:15a In this confidence I intended at first to come to you,

V:15b so that you might twice receive a blessing;

V:16 that is, to pass your way into Macedonia, and again from Macedonia to come to you, and by you to be helped on my journey to Judea.

V:17a Therefore, I was not vacillating when I intended to do this, was I?

V:17b Or what I purpose, do I purpose according to the flesh, so that with me there will be yes, yes and no, no at the same time?

V:18 But as God is faithful, our word to you is not yes and no.

V:19 For the Son of God, Christ Jesus, who was preached among you by us - by me and Silvanus and Timothy

V:19b was not yes and no, but is yes in Him.

V:20a For as many as are the promises of God, in Him they are yes;

V:20b therefore also through Him is our Amen to the glory of God through us
