Here is God's "good news" message and it's power


- 1 Cor 15:3-4 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that <u>Christ died for our sins</u> according to the Scriptures, and that <u>He was buried</u>, and that <u>He was raised on the third day</u> according to the Scriptures.
- 1 Cor 1:18 & 21 For the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the p ²¹ For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not come to know God, God was well-pleased through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe.
- > Christ's work of dying on the cross paid the death penalty for all our

Gospel Came in Power & in the Holy Spirit 1 Thess 1:5-7 Here are some examples of "while in much tribulation, harmonizing with joy from the Holy Spirit" Jn 4:14, "but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst; but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life" The word 'well' is same as in 2 Pt 2:17, $\pi\eta\gamma\dot{\eta}$ 'fountain'. Jn 7:38-39 "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his ermost being will flow rivers of living water. But this He spok the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified." 'Innermost being' is a description of our 'heart', the essence of who we are.
