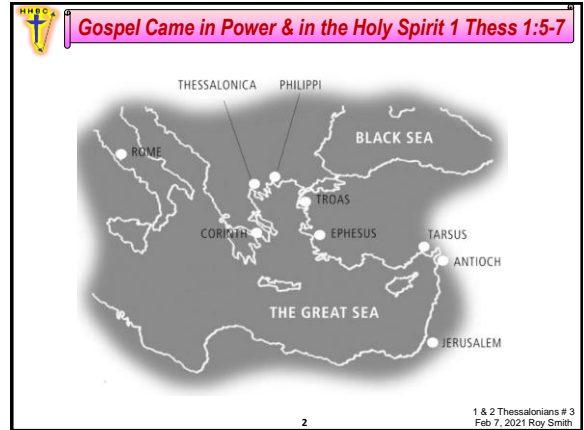

* 1 Paul and Silvanus and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace.

2 We give thanks to God always for all of you, making mention of you in our prayers;

3 constantly bearing in mind your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the presence of our God and Father,

4 knowing, brethren beloved by God, His choice of you;

Note: This thanksgiving to God was for all of them, based on knowing 1 their work out of faith, 2 their labor out of love, and 3 their steadfastness out of hope and knowing the facts that 4 God loved and 5 chose them.

A Small Overview

Chester McCalley wrote in his Commentary on I & II Thessalonians

The first three chapters are a detailed exposition of the words "how you turned to God from idols to serve a living and true God."

The entire book may be divided into two parts.

First, the Thessalonians are reminded of how they had received the word of God (1:1-3:13).

Second, they are told of how they must live the word of God (4:1-5:28).

Observations from 1 Thessalonians 1:5

- > The word "for" gives us the 1st object of the previous action word (verb), and in this case it is "we give thanks" back in v2, they were thankful **because of how God's word came to them**
- * v2 **we give thanks** to God always for all of you... v5 **for** our gospel did not come to you in word only
- > The words "our gospel" tell us this "good news" was personally given by all three who wrote this letter, Paul, Silvanus, & Timothy
- * v5 for **our gospel** did not come to you in word only
- > The "good news" presented **did not come** as words alone communicated by men.
- * v5 for our gospel **did not come to you in word only**
- > The "good news" presented **did come** as words communicated with the power of God the Holy Spirit and the speakers complete certainty
- * v5 for our gospel did not come to you in word only but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction;
- > The "complete certainty" of the presenters was known by seeing the speakers made to give freely this good news for the hearer's benefit.
- * v5 for our gospel did not come to you in word only but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; **just as you know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.**

Observations from 1 Thessalonians 1:6

- The words “you also” gives us the 2nd object of the previous action word (verb), “we give thanks” back in v2, they also were thankful **because of how God’s word was received by them**
- * v2 **we give thanks**... v6 **you also** became imitators of us and of the Lord,
- The words “became imitators” tell us those who believed the good news were **made into imitators** of the messengers and of the Lord.
- * v6 you also **became imitators of us and of the Lord**,
- These believers were **made into imitators** just like the messengers were **made into gospel givers** for the benefit of all who believe.
- * v6 you also **became imitators of us and of the Lord**, v5 you know **what kind of men we proved to be** among you for your sake.
- The “having received” shows the reason they were made imitators, they received the good news by **faith, believing, depending** on it.
- * v6 you also became imitators of us and of the Lord, **having received the word**
- This belief was total dependence upon God, so that even in much tribulation they enjoyed the harmony of joy from the Holy Spirit
- * v6 you also became imitators of us and of the Lord, having received the word **in much tribulation with the joy of the Holy Spirit**

Observations from 1 Thessalonians 1:7

- The words “so that” gives us the 3rd object of the previous action word (verb), “we give thanks” back in v2, they also were thankful **because of how God’s word was handled by them**
- * v2 **we give thanks** to God always for all of you... v7 **so that** you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia.
- The words “became an example” tell us those who believed the good news were **changed into an example**
- * v7 so that **you became an example** to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia.
- The words “to all” tell us those who believed the good news were **changed into an example for all believers locally** in two provinces
- * v7 so that you became an example **to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia**.

Note:
Thessalonica was the capital city of the province Macedonia
Corinth was the capital city of the province Achaia

Here is God’s “good news” message and it’s power

- * 1 Cor 15:3-4 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that **Christ died for our sins** according to the Scriptures, ⁴ and that **He was buried**, and that **He was raised on the third day** according to the Scriptures,
- * 1 Cor 1:18 & 21 For **the word of the cross** is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it **is the power of God**...²¹ For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not **come to know God**, God was well-pleased through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe.
- Christ’s work of dying on the cross paid the death penalty **for** all our sin.
- His death was verified by his body being buried in a tomb.
- His death has been accepted as payment in full for our sin because He has been raised from that one death to everlasting life.

Here are some examples of “while in much tribulation, harmonizing with joy from the Holy Spirit”

- * Jn 4:14, “but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst; but the water that I will give him will become in him a **well of water springing up** to eternal life”.
- The word ‘well’ is same as in 2 Pt 2:17, πηγή ‘fountain’.
- * Jn 7:38-39 “He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, ‘From his **innermost being** will flow rivers of **living water**. But **this He spoke of the Spirit**, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.”
- ‘Innermost being’ is a description of our ‘heart’, the essence of who we are. We and whoever drinks or trusts the water Christ Jesus has given, are now fountains of God’s ‘living water of life’.

Here is another example of “while in much tribulation, harmonizing with joy from the Holy Spirit”

- * Jn 16:12-15 “I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear **them** now. ¹³ “But when **He, the Spirit of truth**, comes, **He will guide you into all the truth**; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose **it** to you. ¹⁵ All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said that **He takes of Mine and will disclose it to you**.”
- God the Son, gave us God the Holy Spirit to share His living water, the things of the Father & Christ, to and through us.
- So it is God who is using us as His own fountains of these things of God, the ‘living water of life’.

Here is an exhortation to fix our eyes on the example of our Lord, Who saw the harmonious joy “set before Him”, and gave Himself as the perfect sacrifice for our sins.

- * Hebrews 12:1 Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,
- ² **fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.**
- ³ For consider Him who has endured such hostility by sinners against Himself, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.
- ⁴ You have not yet resisted to the point of shedding blood in your striving against sin;
