

² May it never be! How shall we who died to [the] sin still live in it?³ Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death? ⁴Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. 5 For if we have become united with Him in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be in the likeness of His resurrection, ⁶ knowing this, that our old self [man] was crucified with *Him*, in order that our body of [the] sin might be done away with [taken offline], so that we would no longer be slaves to [the] sin; ⁷ for he who has died is freed from [the] sin. ⁸ Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, 9 knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, is never to die again; death no longer is master over Him. 10 For the death that He died, He died to [the] sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.

Definition of words used in today's verses

baptism – is when we were immersed into Christ and became identified with Him*

the old self [man] - all that we were in Adam (totally depraved, lacking the life of God)


the sin = the sin nature (Adam's fallen nature)
crucified – put to death*

done away with – rendered inoperative, taken offline


body of sin – all that the sin nature stands for (the corpse of sin)*

How do we walk in **newness of life**?



- We have seen from verse 4 that God's desire is that we walk in our new life in Christ
- This is based on our being buried with Him and raised with Him
- Now verses 5 and 6 will give more details on how this was accomplished
- The words "we have" is used to show us that every believer has these facts that describe who they are in Christ




- Christ died to the sin nature for all believers




- * Our old man & body of sin is rendered inoperative put in idle, taken offline or out of gear

- * We are free to live with Christ moment by moment




Being Freed From Our Sin Nature*
