<sup>11</sup> who must be silenced because they are upsetting whole families, teaching things they should not teach for the sake of sordid gain.

<sup>12</sup> One of themselves, a prophet of their own, said, "Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, lazy gluttons."

- 3. What do you think the main flaw is with a false teacher?

- 6. What was the motive of these false teachers?
- 7. Is the word "upsetting" strong enough to convey the meaning in verse 11?
- 8. What did this false teaching do?
- 9. Who was the prophet that Paul refers to?
