*Titus 2:1-5 (NASB)*

<sup>1</sup> *But as for you, speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine.*

<sup>2</sup> *Older men are to be temperate, dignified, sensible, sound in faith, in love, in perseverance.*

<sup>3</sup> *Older women likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips nor enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good,*

<sup>4</sup> *so that they may encourage the young women to love their husbands, to love their children,*

<sup>5</sup> *to be sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands, so that the word of God will not be dishonored.*
