Read verses 13-14 of Titus Chapter 2 and answer the following questions.

TITUS 2:13-14

¹³ looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus,

¹⁴ who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

1. What does the word “looking” mean in this context?
2. Can you connect “the blessed hope” with “the glorious appearing” of the glory?
3. Can you also connect “the great God” with “our Savior Jesus Christ”?
4. Why does Paul “our” before “great God and Savior Jesus Christ”?
5. What is the blessed hope we have?
6. Is it “the glorious appearing” or “the appearing of the glory”?
7. In verse 14, what does the word “for” reveal to us?
8. Let’s talk about redemption. What does it mean?
9. Is lawlessness an indication of sin?
10. Who are “the people of His own possession”?
11. What makes them zealous for good works?
