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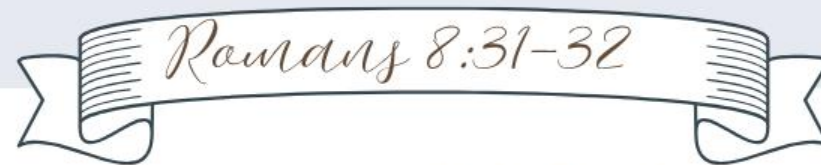

you together with Him.



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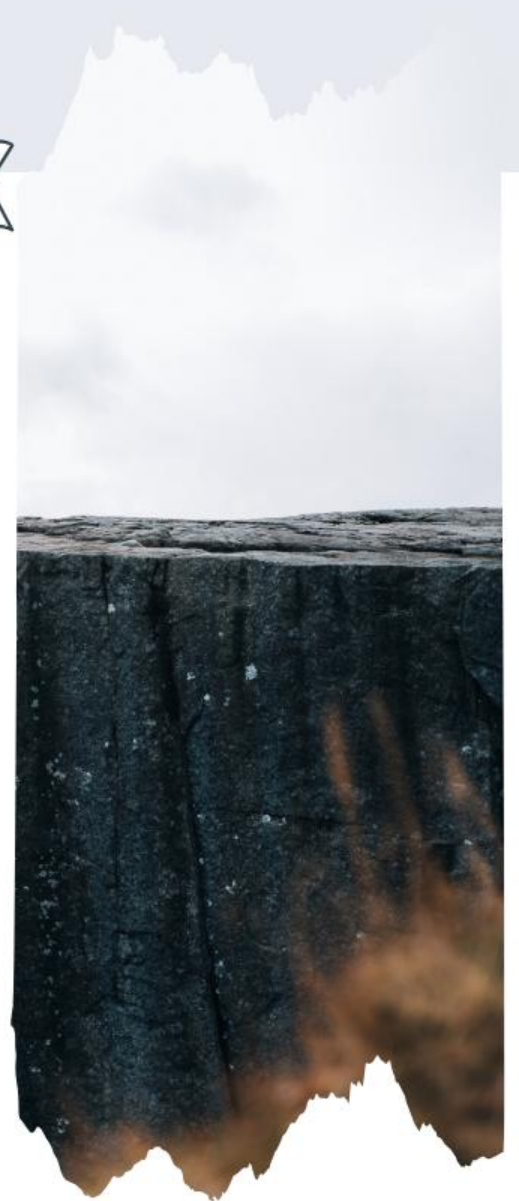

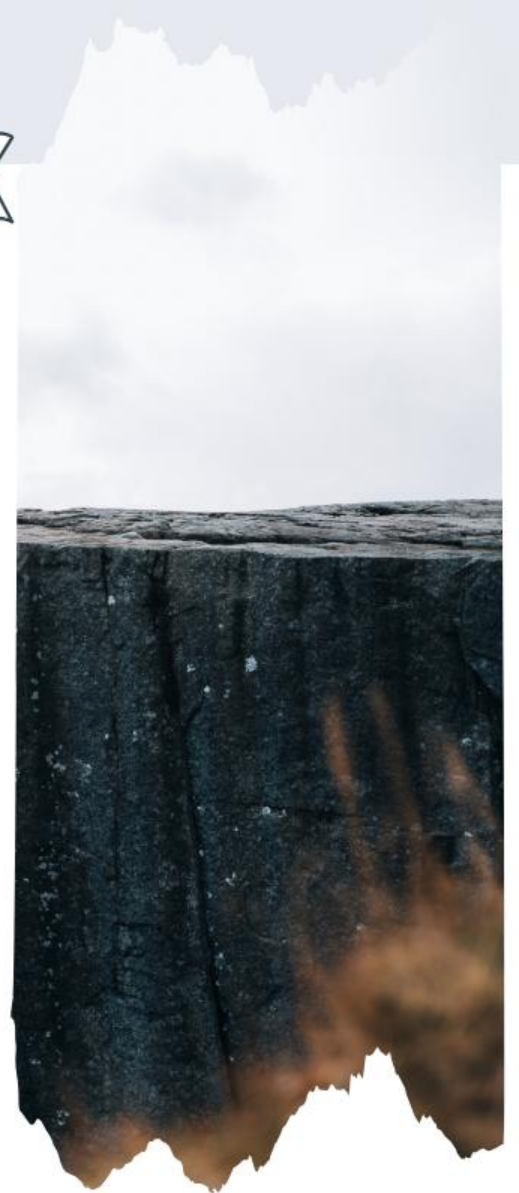

is against me!”**



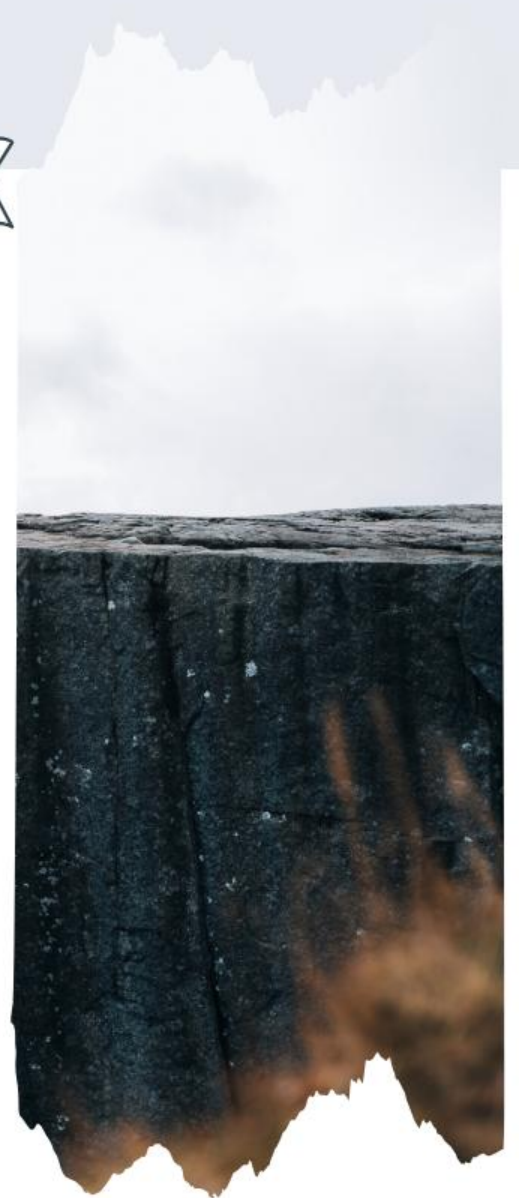

to accomplish His **good!**

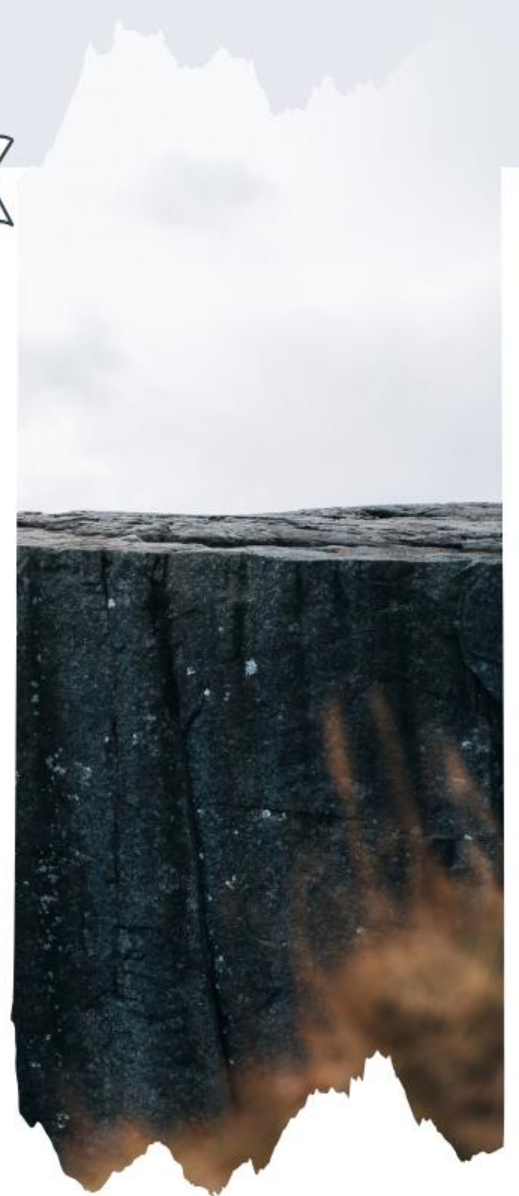

If He allows something to happen to you, you can guarantee that He is using it to conform you to Christ!

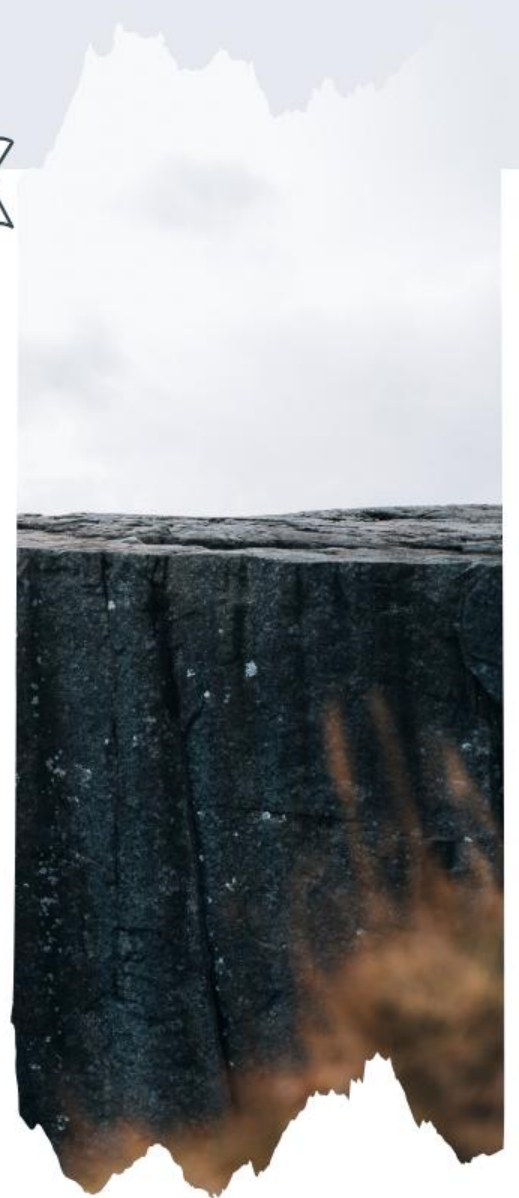

co-heirs with Christ.

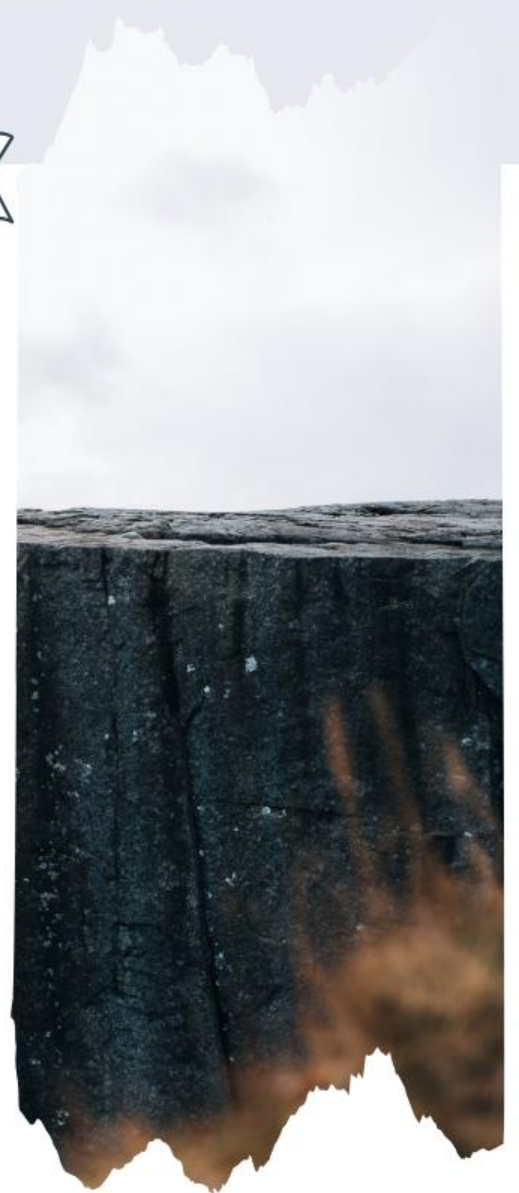


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Romans 8:31-32
