1 Peter 2:18-20 (NASB)

18 Servants be submissive to your masters with all respect not only to those who are good and gentle, but also to those who are unreasonable.

19 For this *finds* favor if for the sake of conscience toward God a person bears up under sorrows when suffering unjustly.

20 For what credit is there if when you sin and are harshly treated you endure it with patience? But if when you do what is right and suffer *for it* you patiently endure it, this *finds* favor with God.

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- vv13-17 - submission to government (human institutions)
- vv18-25 - slaves to masters
- 3:1-6 - wives to husbands
- 3:7 - husbands to wives

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- 3:7 - husbands to wives

1 Peter 2:12

Keep your behavior excellent among the Gentiles, so that in the thing in which they slander you as evildoers, they may because of your good deeds, as they observe *them*, glorify God in the day of visitation.

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If someone is in authority over you, respect that!

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From God's perspective, it's a beautiful thing when you and I bear up under suffering situations.
