

What is the essence of faith? God's total revelation to man

Most through the Bible, some through general revelation.

What's the source of the essence of faith?

Hebrews 12:1

Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, 2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of the faith; Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Hebrews 12:2 - Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of the faith.

POSOLUTE CERTAINTY

Hebrews 11:1 = the essence of Biblical faith

Hebrews 11:2-12:1 = personal faith (resting in the essence of faith)
Hebrews 12:2 = Jesus Christ is the author & finisher of the faith

The faith in scripture is used three ways:

- 1. the essence of faith
- 2. a portion of the essence of faith
- 3. personal faith

Hebrews 12:2 - Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of the faith.

The word here for 'author' is used only 4 times in scripture in the New Testament.

Acts 3:15 & 5:31 - prince
Hebrews 2:10 - captain
Hebrews 12:2 - author
author, originator, founder,
prince, leader, captain

Acts 3: 11

And as the lame man which was healed held Peter and John, all the people ran together unto them in the porch that is called Solomon's, greatly wondering.

12 And when Peter saw *it*, he answered unto the people, Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power or holiness we had made this man to walk? 13 The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified His Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied Him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let *Him* go.

14 But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you;

15 And killed the **Prince** of life(Author of life), Whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses.

Revelation 3: 14

And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning (similar to author) of the creation of God

John 1:3

All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made

Hebrews 2:9

But we see Jesus, Who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honor; that He by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

10 For it was fitting for Him, for Whom are all things, and through Whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to perfect (to bring to a goal) the author of their salvation through sufferings. (NAS)

Not only is Jesus Christ the author or the originator of all physical life, but He's the author and He's the originator of all spiritual life.

Hebrews 12:2 - Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of the faith.

finisher = completer, one who brings to a goal

The Lord Jesus Christ is both the <u>author</u> and the one who <u>brings to a goal</u> the faith.

How does God convey faith's essence? by declaring, revealing & sharing His glory

Romans 10:1

Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved.

10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 11 For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on Him shall not be ashamed. 12 For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon Him.

13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved
