<p>Why Are We Studying This Together?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Because you can't do it alone – it must be done by a group • If you want to be part of the work of the Holy Spirit's fulfillment of God's logical imperatives here you must do this together with me and together as a body • We must do this together, we're a body! 	<p>Single Adults</p> <p>Principles for consideration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The characteristics described for a godly woman or man are the same: married or single • You can still have deep relationships with other believers (appropriately) • You can still find examples from other believers who will edify you
<p>Parents with Young Children</p> <p>Principles for consideration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fathers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Be the model of the husband you want your daughter to marry – Be the model of the husband you want your son to be so that when he gets married he can treat his wife as prescribed in this passage 	<p>Parents with Young Children</p> <p>Principles for consideration</p> <p>Mothers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Be the model of the wife you want your daughter to be when she gets married – Be the model of the wife you want your daughter to be so that when she gets married she can treat her husband as prescribed in this passage
<p>Parents with Young Children</p> <p>Principles for consideration</p> <p>Parents</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Love your children in the way they ought to love your grandchildren down the road (NOT by spoiling them) – Seek out wisdom from other older parents if you've run out of your wits end – Consider sharing ideas you've had yourself (in non-invasive ways) 	<p>The Fruit of Abiding in the Spirit</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • None of what we've covered is remotely possible without the believer abiding in Christ • This is not a social construct, it's the construct of the body of Christ, which is better described as an organism • This is viewed in grace! When we blow it, we can still find growth in the learning opportunity.

Consider

If You're Older

- Seek out a younger believer or believers to fellowship with and exercise your calling as a mature believer to edify those who are younger
- Pray for the "youngins"

If You're Younger

- Seek out an older believer or older believers to fellowship with and exercise your calling as a younger believer to be edified by the older believers
- Pray for the "not-so-youngins"
