Read: Romans Chapter 6:1-3

1. In verse 1, what does continue in sin mean?
2. By what logic would grace increase if we continued in sin?
3. What is the expanded answer to the question in verse 1? (See verse 2)
4. Why is living any longer in sin, just not the norm of the believer?
5. Who controls the sin nature in the believer?
6. Do we have the freedom to plead with God, the power of a tendency to sin, over which there is no control?
7. What does the word baptism mean?
8. At what point in the history of Christ does a believer become identified with Christ?
9. By being “in” Christ, what events in Christ’s life does the believer partake in?
10. Is this a new principle God has just instituted?
11. Baptism is the cause, what are the effects of our baptism into Christ?
12. From an identification standpoint, does baptismal water have any spiritual effect upon a person?
