Questions for Lesson 11 The Identification Truths

- 1. From a worldly viewpoint, what does burial prove has taken place?
- 2. What is God's object or aim in our being identified in Christ's burial?
- 3. What does verse 4 tells us it took to raise Christ from the dead?
- 4. Can you describe what "newness of life" is and means?
- 5. Is there a difference between the resurrection of Christ to newness of life and the "coming forth" of Lazarus from the grave? Explain
- 6. If we were baptized into Christ's death, what involvement do we have with Him when He is raised to "newness of life".
- 7. What is our identity with the sin nature and the whole sphere of the 1st Adam life now?
- 8. In verse 4 the King James says we "should walk in newness of life." The word walk means to "grow together". What do you think is the source and energy of this walk?
- 9. In verse 6 "knowing" can mean "coming to know", how do we come to know facts like these?
- 10. Describe what your old man is?
- 11. Does the old man being crucified mean that he is obliterated, eradicated, and gone forever?
- 12. Have you counted yourself so incorrigibly bad that being crucified is the only proper remedy for your old man?
- 13. Why wouldn't dying to yourself be appropriate in light of this verse?
