2. Describe the difference between Romans 6:14 and 1 Corinthians 9:21 as regards one association with law?
3. What relationship does a believer have with the law?
4. What is the answer to the question in verse 1?
5. What is the answer to the question in verse 15?
6. In verse 17 and 18, what does it mean to be a bondservant, either of sin or to righteousness?
7. What does it mean to be delivered over to a form of doctrine?
8. Do we as believers have the power to prevent and stop sin in our lives because we have the will to do so?
9. Can law secure obedience to God?
10. In verse 20, 21 we were servants to sin. What is the answer to the question "what fruit had you at that time?"
11. How were we made free from sin and put into service to God?
12. What does it mean, in verse 23, the end is eternal life?
13. In verse 23 we had to work in order to get pain. What was the work and what was the payment?
14. Do we have to work for the gift of eternal life?
