- verse 26 let us make man in Our image
 - according to Our likeness
 - rule over ... fish, birds, cattle etc.
- verse 27 God created man in His own image
 - in the image of God He created them
 - be fruitful and multiply
- verse 30 God saw all that He made & behold it was very good

What happened to man's image and likeness when Adam fell? - Gen. 5:3


- God's detailed design of man Gen. 2
- verse 7 LORD God formed man of dust from the ground (material part of man)
 - and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life [plural lives] and man became a <u>living soul</u>* (<u>immaterial</u> part of man)
 - man is said to have a body, soul and spirit 1 Thess. 5:23, Heb. 4:1
- * living being in NASB



Adam before The Fall

- God's original home and instructions for man Gen. 2
 - verse 9 LORD God caused to grow every tree that is pleasing to the sight and good for food
 - the tree of life
 - the tree of the knowledge of good and evil
 - verse 16 LORD God ~ from any tree of the garden you may eat freely
 - verse 17 from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat
 - for in the day that you eat from it you will <u>surely die</u> [dying you will surely die]

God's testing of man - Gen. 3

- verse 1 -The serpent was more crafty than any beast of the field
 He said ~ Indeed, has God said, you shall not eat from any tree of the garden?
- verse 4 The serpent said ~ You surely shall not die ~
- verse 5 For God knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil

The effect upon the race of Adam's Fall

- Doctrine of imputation*
 - The sin of Adam is imputed to his posterity Rom. 5:12-14
 - The sin of man is imputed to Christ -1 Pet 2:24, 2 Cor.5:21a
 - The righteousness of God is imputed to those who believe Rom.4:3, 2 Cor.5::
- Holy judgments of God rest upon all men outside of Christ Rom 3:23
- The penalties resting on the "old creation" -Eph. 2:1 & 4:17-19, Rev. 21:8
