

#### The Seven Parables of Matthew 13

- parable of the Sower, the Seed and the Soil
- parable of the Tares among the Wheat
- parable of the Mustard seed
- parable of the Leaven
- parable of the Hidden Treasure

- parable of the Dragnet
- parable parabole(gk) placing of one thing beside another with a view to comparison (an illustration of a truth)
- mystery knowledge withheld, not previously revealed (Matt.13:35)
- kingdom of heaven God's rule on the earth, embraces any sort of empire that God may have on the earth at a given time



- Guide to interpretation of Parables\*
- Determine the exact nature and details of the customs, practices and elements that form the material or natural part or the parable ---
- Determine the one central truth the parable is attempting to teach
- Determine how much of the parable is interpreted by the Lord Himself ---
- Determine if there are any clues in the context as to the parable's meaning
- Don't make a parable walk on all fours ---
- · Be careful of the doctrinal use of parables
- A clear understanding of the time-period that many of the parables are intended for is necessary for their full interpretation




### The Present Age until Christ Comes

- Some seeds fell beside the road, and the birds came and ate them up.


- The seed beside the road is when anyone hears the word of the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what has been sown in his heart
- The seed on the rocky places, this is the man who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; yet he has no firm root in himself, but is only temporary, and when affliction or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he falls away.
- The seed was sown among the thorns, this is the man who hears the word, and the worry of the world and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful.
- The seed was on the good soil, this is the man who hears the word and
  understands it; who indeed bears fruit and brings forth, some a hundredfold,
  some sixty, and some thirty.

- The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a man who sowed good seed in his field.
- his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went away
- the wheat sprouted and bore grain, then the tares became evident also
- Do you want us, then, to go and gather them up?'
- No; for while you are gathering up the tares, you may uproot the wheat with them.
- Allow both to grow together until the harvest
  - gather up the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them up
  - · gather the wheat into my barn

## Explanation of the Tares among the Wheat

- The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man,
- · the field is the world
- the good seed, these are the sons of the kingdom
- the tares are the sons of the evil one;
- the enemy who sowed them is the devil
- the harvest is the end of the age; and the reapers are angels.

 The Leaven Matt 13:33


 The kingdom of heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three pecks of flour until it was all leavened

- So it will be at the end of the age; the angels will come forth and take out the wicked from among the righteous, will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
